Morality and Justice in Higher Education

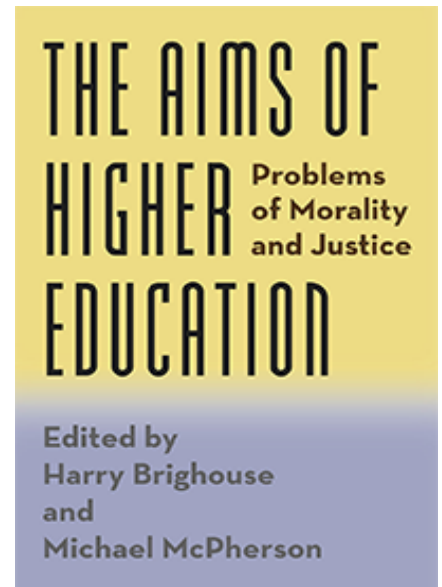
A conversation with **Harry Brighouse**
